



KANSAS NATIONAL GUARD FOUNDATION EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION

Submission may be completed electronically to ksngfoundation@gmail.com or hard copy to Kansas National Guard Foundation, 125 SE Airport Drive, Topeka, KS 66619.

Each year, members of the Foundation will make scholarship determinations based on the requirements below and reward scholarships in increments of \$1,000 each up to a total of five scholarships.

The closing date for submission to the Kansas National Guard Foundation will be not later than March 1. Scholarship checks awarded will be made out to the applicable educational institution.

Eligibility: A qualifying applicant for a Kansas National Guard Foundation Scholarship must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a United States Citizen.
2. Must be a current Kansas high school senior who will graduate in the current academic year and have one parent or guardian who is a current/retired member of the Kansas National Guard.
3. Provide a letter of recommendation from a current high school educator/counselor or a current employer/supervisor.
4. Provide a letter of acceptance from an accredited college, university, community college, or licensed vocational school if available. Applicants will have one year from 1 May of the current academic year to claim the scholarship. When a claim is submitted, applicant must include the letter of acceptance and proof of enrollment in the institution to the Kansas National Guard Foundation.
5. Provide proof that states their un-weighted grade point average is a minimum of 2.5.

Selection Criteria: The Kansas National Guard Foundation will grant awards to students based on the following criteria:

1. Meet the criteria listed above
2. Demonstrate good citizenship, high moral character, attitude, and leadership potential as documented in the submitted letter of recommendation and application.
3. Demonstrate efficient and effective use of time for academics, job experience, if employed, and extracurricular activities involved in as documented in the submitted letter of recommendation.

Explain how you use your extracurricular time. Include community service, volunteer activities, and civic awards and recognition.
